286. HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TRANSPORT VISION 2050

Whilst the Committee could see some advantages to a bypass for Hertford, nevertheless concern was expressed regarding the likelihood of increased housing through infill as a result which would not be beneficial to Hertford. The Committee believed that as members they were charged with the protection of Hertford and not commuters passing through Hertford.

In regard to increased use in train services, the Committee considered that this would only be viable once greater capacity for car parking at the stations had been addressed.
