Objection. The design of the proposal was considered totally inappropriate and completely out of keeping with the surrounding area, being immediately adjacent to the Conservation Area. The impact on the station shop and the nearby Sele shops was also considered a cause for concern, as was the loss of the current building, which is of a high quality. Consideration of the possibility of retaining the existing building as street frontage for a retail outlet (as companies like Wetherspoons have successfully done elsewhere) met with some favour at committee.
