### **HERTFORD TOWN COUNCIL AWARDS COMMUNITY GRANTS**

On Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June, Hertford Town Council's Finance, Policy and Administration Committee awarded grants totalling £2700 to a number of Hertford-based organisations and good causes.

The Town Council earlier in the year announced that a Community Grant fund of £16,000 had been set aside for the financial year 2017/18.

The funding can be awarded for a range of purposes, including public events, projects being undertaken by local voluntary organisations and endeavours by individuals which show a clear benefit to Hertford residents.

Applications are welcomed and should be completed by 29<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

Councillors considered three applications and agreed that the following sums be awarded:

Hertford International Concert Series were awarded a grant of £1200 towards the cost of performers' fees.

East Herts Diversionary Activities were awarded a grant of £1000 towards the cost of the 2017 programme of activities for young people.

Sele Farm Womens' Club were awarded a grant of £500 to assist with funding towards the cost of two events to celebrate the clubs 60 year anniversary.

Chairman of the Finance, Policy and Administration Committee, Cllr Bob Deering, said:  
"I am very pleased that Hertford Town Council has been able to provide grant funding to a number of worthy local organisations. All the recipients make an important contribution to life in Hertford. We hope the amounts will make a difference and show all those who give so much of their time that the efforts put in are recognised and valued."
